





## TRAVEL THROUGH THE RESPIRATORY SYSTEM















- NOSE: FILTER THE AIR BEFORE ENTERING THE LUNGS
- PHARYNX: CONNECTS THE NASAL CAVITY TO THE REST OF THE RESPIRATORY SYSTEM
- LARYNX: PRODUCES SOUNDS AND CONNECTS THE PHARYNX TO THE TRACHEA
- TRACHEA: COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE WINDPIPE
- BRONCHUS: TWO BIG TUBES THAT BRING AIR FROM
  THE WINDPIPE INTO THE LUNGS
- BRONCHIOLE: LOCATED AT THE END OF THE BRONCHUS AND CARRY AIR TO THE ALVEOLI
  - ALVEOLI: SMALL SACS WHERE GAS EXCHANGE
    TAKES PLACE
