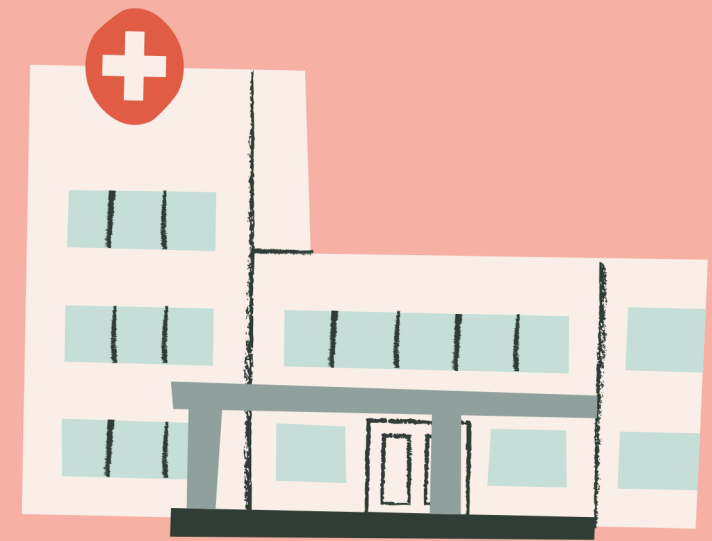


MEDICAL MAP



Doctor orders blood sugar checks and prescribes insulin or oral medication.



First point of contact: Doctor, Nurse Practitioner or Walk-in clinic for mild-moderate symptoms, ER or call 911 for severe symptoms. Referral to dietician and diabetes resource center for ongoing support .



Medical Laboratory Technologists do specific lab tests for diagnosing diabetes and do ongoing lab tests that complement blood sugar checks.



Patient Care Attendant or nurse checks blood sugar levels as prescribed by the Doctor.



Nurse administers medication prescribed by doctor and documents.
