## Nurse

### Registered Nurse

**Average Income NB: \$83,850**

Provides direct patient care, health education, assesses patients, administers treatments, and monitors recovery in hospitals or clinics.

### Licensed Practical Nurse

**Average Income NB: \$60,450**

Provides support and care to patients across various settings. Work with Registered Nurse's and Doctors in health education, assessments and treatments.

## Sonographer

**Average Income NB: \$74,100**

Uses ultrasound equipment to obtain images for diagnostic examinations and assists in interpreting results.

## Optometrist

**Average Income Canada: \$81,000**

Performs eye exams, diagnoses vision problems and ocular diseases, and prescribes corrective lenses or treatments.

## Respiratory Therapist

**Average Income NB: \$68,250**

Assesses, treats, and manages patients with breathing or cardiopulmonary disorders in hospital and clinic settings.

## Physiotherapist

**Average Income NB: \$78,000**

Assesses and treats physical impairments, injuries, or disabilities to improve mobility and function using exercise and manual therapy.

## Paramedic

**Average Income NB: \$61,000**

Delivers emergency out-of-hospital care, assesses patients, and provides advanced medical interventions during transport.

## Nurse Practitioner

**Average Income NB: \$105,300**

Diagnoses and treats illness, orders and interprets tests, prescribes medications, and manages primary patient care in collaboration or independently.

## Dentist

**Average Income NB: \$132,000**

Diagnoses and treats problems of the teeth, gums, and mouth, and provides preventive and restorative dental care.

## Doctor

### Family doctor

**Average Income NB: \$187,297**

Diagnoses and treats illnesses and injuries, prescribes medication, and provides continuous care to patients in clinics, hospitals, or private practice.

## Personal Support Worker

**Average Income NB: \$46,800**

Assists clients with activities of daily living such as dressing, bathing, eating, and more.

## Dental Hygienist

**Average Income NB: \$74,100**

Cleans teeth, examines patients for oral diseases, and provides preventative dental care and education.

## Radiologic Technologist

**Average Income NB: \$68,000**

Operates imaging equipment and performs diagnostic imaging examinations such as X-rays.

## MRI Technologist

**Average Income NB: \$68,000**

Operates magnetic resonance imaging equipment to capture detailed images for medical diagnosis.

## Medical Laboratory Technologist

**Average Income NB: \$67,782**

Conducts laboratory tests and analyses on body samples to assist in the diagnosis and treatment of diseases.

## Occupational Therapist

**Average Income NB: \$81,000**

Helps individuals achieve independence in daily activities through therapeutic interventions and adaptive strategies.

## Social Worker

**Average Income NB: \$78,000**

Assesses the needs of clients and seek out the proper resources and services to ensure the client accesses the support they need.

## Speech-Language Pathologist

**Average Income NB: \$88,491**

Assesses and treats speech, language, voice, and communication disorders.
