



## EMC'S WILWORKS YOUTH IN MANUFACTURING PROGRAM

**Eligibility:** All youth aged 16-20 located in Atlantic Canada (NB, NL, NS, PEI) and eligible to work in Canada.

**Work Placement:** Gain 8-10 weeks of manufacturing experience coupled with foundational training.

**Micro-Credential Training:** Participating youth can earn EMC's Manufacturing Foundations and Lean Fundamentals micro-credentials to help them master key areas like problem-solving, difficult interactions, lean thinking and value stream mapping.

**Mentorship:** Atlantic Canadian employers involved in the program will receive mentorship training for current employees at no cost.

**Networking:** EMC connects employers and educators, solidifying the path from school to the workforce.
